Project Title	Land, Housing and Property Restitution in Northern Province
Project Locations	Vavuniya, Jaffna, Kilinochchi, Mullaitivu and Mannar Districts
Brief Background of the Project	<p>Since the beginning of returns in April 2009, approximately 496,584 IDPs have returned to their homes/places of origin. Since 2010, there are 3773 refugee returnee families returned to North and East. Today land disputes affect most of the returnee communities. Many are landless and are found to be families headed by women. Among the land issues, inaccessibility to their land and land disputes related to land permits could be observed.</p> <p>Secondary occupation of land by the military and multiple displacements has created many ownership and possession disputes. Large acres of land are used as high security zones, for military usage or for development purposes. This has resulted in large scale displacement and relocation. The affected people have had little or no means to a fair redress mechanism to either claim their land or obtain fair compensation.</p> <p>Government departments at district levels have either little or no knowledge in directing the persons affected to resolve their land disputes. There are many individual cases that still remain unresolved.</p>

	<p>Given the complexity of land issues in North especially after decades of civil war and multiple displacements, there are complex and specific challenges the IDP returnees and Refugee returnees face. Therefore the assistance in legal aid for civilians and guidance for government institutions is vital.</p> <p>The overall purpose of this project is to facilitate the process of resolving land issues faced by the civilians, strengthen the knowledge of the refugee returnees and IDPs returnees to access the required services in resolving the land disputes and to give Legal representation for the most vulnerable.</p>
